And for those of you who view, create, aspire-to-create-view-enjoy an Anime Music Video [AMV]—it is hardly definable as an 'AMV' if there is no 'M' in the 'AMV' [A-V is kind of boring don't ya think? ^^];

So the remedy? =) I actually should have thought of this over a year ago now... but didn't so me'h =3 I simply uploaded it to MetaCafe and pretty much anyone besides YouTube doesn't have the same insidious 'deal' with the less-gracious-more-greedy-record-company which I shall not name and allowed me to share my AMV in full form with individuals and groups as of today! YAY! =D

MetaCafe also seems to be more 'AMV' friendly and understanding [YouTube took down one of my crudely themed 'Hentai Parodies' much thanks to one offended individual who flagged it—no visible content mind you but apparently it got under SOMEONE'S Skin ^_^ Aaaanyway...]

To date, this is my latest AMV from the excellent series known as "The Melancholy of Haruhi Suzumiya" and to be honest, this idea had been creeping about within the depths of my subconscious mind since I saw the original first season of The Melancholy of Haruhi Suzumiya... but there was not enough footage of Tsuruya—Mikuru's uptempo and uber-bubbly [megas-bubbly in the tongue of Tsuruya! ^_^] to make the video "Tsu Tsu Tsu Tsuruya!" a full video reality. =) After season two was released [many thanks to 'A.F.K.' I actually did quite a bit of Audio editing in order to present this fun-and-elegant-uptempo-megas-multi-comedy-parody-of-a-song-parody-of-an-anime-and-character-name-and-persona to what is currently seen. =) To be honest... I am curious to see what happens in Season 3—but I shall not ramble! AMV talk!

Truly and honestly this song [recorded the year I was born oddly enough: Yup! ^_^ 1984 – Year of The Macintosh! =D] similarity to the character name of "Tsuruya"—a character presented to the public clearly over two decades later—somehow correlated the first time I heard the name "Tsuruya." To be honest—up until I took the time to sit down and put together this AMV and receive the song "Sussudio..." I thought that "Sussudio" WAS spelled "TsuTsudia" believe it or not. O.O

[I typically do not pay a lot of attention to songs spelling or even the lyrics to them unless pulling them apart, remixing them, or placing them in a project like this]. In fact... my first initial google search was for "TsuTsudia" then "SuSudia" then "Suridia" and "Suridia" suggested, "Do you mean Sussudio?" And I clicked the link and FINALLY learned the spelling of this song which to be honest—I only recall hopping into my head after viewing a film featuring the song in it! Wasn't much of a Phil Collins Listener while growing up. A lot of R&B and Disco and Funk but I do not recall hearing this song consistently until well into my twenties-believe-it-or-not! =) And for better or worse first heard the song in Mary Harron's film

rendition of “American Psycho” O.O [And I did not know that “Mary Harron” had done “American Psycho” until I had seen “I Shot Andy Warhol” and a reference online O.O]. So to say the least...

I could not have planned to make this AMV =3 It just kind of... happened. =)

And to be completely honest I am glad that it did! =D

As of now the video is live on MetaCafe and here soon I will be releasing all of my AMVs to Animemusicvideo.org. =) A Website that I have admired for a while and where a friend would consistently share with me the awesomeness of AMVs made outside of a streaming service before I even was aware of what “Myspace” or “YouTube” or any “Streaming” service was! =)

In addition to this... also will be the first 3 AMVs that guided me to the footage used in the “Tsu Tsu Tsu Tsuruya AMV:” “Time,” “Déjà vu,” and “Déjà vu Thesis Edit” [not to mention the video that was inspired WHILE making “Tsu Tsu Tsu Tsuruya:” “Mikuru Thriller!” =)]

And just so you know... I am not ever worried about accusations of ‘doing what others do.’ I truly did just happen upon shaping these specific AMVs in this specific order and although I am well aware that there are thousands—if not HUNDREDS of thousands of “The Melancholy of Haruhi Suzumiya” AMV and Videos out there based around the anime series, Light Novel series or video games or fan art—I do not create things for others first. If I am passionate about making a video or song or movie [for example like Tsu, Tsu, Tsu, Tsuruya or the “Infinite-8” video 3-part series] I simply just “Do it.” It is a given that people build off of one another’s ideas even if only on a subconscious level but I don’t even worry about all of that. =) I simply just do what I am passionate about—what feels ‘Right.’ [to me as an individual].
